**Defense Finance and Accounting Service (DFAS) related forms for unpaid retirement compensation and for starting survivor's SBP Annuity:**

*NOTE: The MOAACC Survivor Assistance Team (SAT) member will offer to fill out the SF1174, DD2656-7, FMS2231, and the W4-P for the Surviving Spouse, and then escort the Spouse to the PAFB Casualty Assistance Office and have the Casualty Assistance Representative complete the processing of the forms.*

*After the Casualty Assistance Office actions are complete, the MOAACC SAT member will normally escort the Surviving Spouse to the PAFB Badge and ID office to get the required new Military ID Card to update the Survivor in the DEERS system.*

- **SF 1174** (Claim for Unpaid Compensation...)  
*Claim for Veteran's Unpaid Retirement income*
  - Scroll down to "**Casualty Assistance**" Header
  - Click on **SF 1174**

**DD Form 2656-7** (Verification for Survivor Annuity):

*Claim for starting Survivor's SBP Annuity*

- Scroll to "**Annuity Assistance**" Header
- Click on **DD 2656-7**

**FMS Form 2231** (Fast Start Direct Deposit)

*Direct Deposit Sign-Up Form (standard way of Annuity Payments)*

- Scroll to "**Bank and Checking Forms**" Header
- Click on **FMS 2231**
- **Bring a voided check to set up receipt of payments**

Form W4-P (Withholding Certificate for Pension or Annuity Payments)

*Required because Annuity is subject to Federal Income Tax*

- Scroll to "Tax Forms" Header
- Click on **IRS W4P** (do not click on the plain IRS W4 link)

**Veterans Affairs (VA) forms for One Sum Payment for Government Life Insurance and DIC Payments**

*NOTE: The MOAACC SAT member will offer to fill out the form 29-4125 for the Surviving Spouse, and then escort the Surviving Spouse to the Brevard VA Services Office and have the VA Services Counselor complete the processing for the VA Insurance Claim as well as for any DIC claim, and Funeral/Burial benefits due from the VA.*

- **VA Form 29-4125** (Claim for One Sum Payment)  
If the Veteran had Government Life Insurance

Bring a voided check to set up receipt of payment.
- **VA Form 21-534** (Application for DIC, Death Pension, and Accrued Benefits)  
*If a Disability Rating was assigned from the VA, the Surviving Spouse may be eligible for a disability Annuity*
